

INDUSTRY TRAINING AUTHORITY BYLAW

Bylaw: Accredited Industry Training Programs

Bylaw Number: B1001

Definition:

An Accredited Training Program is a program that has been designated by the Minister responsible for the *Industry Training Authority Act* by way of regulation as an accredited program and approved by the ITA Board of Directors. These programs follow national standards, include in-school and employment-based training, and employer attestation of competency. Successful completion of an Accredited Industry Training Program results in the issuance of a *Certificate of Qualification* with an Inter-Provincial Red-Seal endorsement.
