

INDUSTRY TRAINING AUTHORITY BYLAW

Bylaw: Recognized Industry Training Programs

Bylaw Number: B1002

Definition:

A Recognized Training Program is one that has been approved by the Industry Training Authority Board of Directors and is consistent with the Industry Training Authority policy “Criteria for Approving Training Programs”. These programs follow provincial standards, include in-school and employment-based training, and employer attestation of competency. Successful completion of a Recognized Industry Training Program results in the issuance of a *Certificate of Qualification*.
