Summary:	After September 1, 2023, please implement Harmonized Level 2 (HL2) and Harmonized Level 3 (HL3). All levels of the Current (pre-harmonized) program will be phased out after September 1, 2023.			
Standardized Level Exams:	HL2 Standardized Level Exam (SLE): The HL2 SLE is in development. An Official Program Standards Notification (OPSN) will be sent to announce its implementation. Until the SLE is launched, the class mark will serve as the final mark.			
	Please note that the <b>CL2 SLE has been inactivated</b> and <b>cannot</b> be used with an HL2 class as the content is not aligned.			
	<b>HL3:</b> There is no SLE requirement for technical training. Apprentices write the Interprovincial Red Seal Exam as their final assessment.
