Effective Date:	April 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2024
Summary:	Starting <b>April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024</b> , apprentices are not required to write the SkilledTradesBC SLEs until the exams are aligned with the <b>2024 Carpenter Program Outline</b> and the <b>2024 British Columbia Building Code</b> .
Details:	Apprentices enrolled in the Carpenter program at all levels of technical training beginning on, or after, <b>April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024</b> are not required to write the SkilledTradesBC SLEs. For classes ending before the launch of the updated SLEs, the final mark for the level will be based solely on in-school assessments.
	Throughout 2024, the Carpenter program SLEs will be updated to align with the <b>2024</b> <b>Carpenter Program Outline</b> and with the <b>2024 British Columbia Building Code (BCBC)</b> . SLEs will be re-implemented as they are developed, and announced through an Official Program Standards Notice (OPSN).
